** ALL students are required to carry an IMG Academies approved US insurance card from a US insurance company. If you do have an IMG Academies approved US insurance card from a US insurance company, this does not apply to you. In the event that you do not have an accepted US insurance it must be purchased.

Step 5: Payment Information and Optional Payment Plan

A \$4,000 deposit is required to reserve a space in a IMG Academies sport program, but does not guarantee acceptance. Upon acceptance the IMG Academies admissions department will send registration and enrollment information.

FULL TIME SPORTS PROGRAM TUITION: Payment in full (minus the non-refundable \$4,000 deposit) is due by August 1st or FOUR (4) weeks prior to arrival.

PAYMENT PLAN DETAILS: The Payment Plan is paid in NINE (9) installments throughout the year and Tuition Insurance is mandatory.

Payment ONE (1) is due August 1st, 2010 and will include:

30%
of your sport program tuition, optional
upgrades and athletic development plans

PLUS (+)

Deposits, fees and tuition insurance

MINUS (-)

\$4000 deposit.

Payments TWO-NINE (2-9) will be split into EIGHT (8) equal installments and will be due the 1st of each month starting on September 1st and ending on April 1st.

Note: All tuition balances are payable by wire transfer, check drawn on US bank or cash delivered in person. No credit cards will be accepted; however a credit card must be kept on file and will be charged in case of delinquencies.

Academics: Application, acceptance, student visas and tuition payment to all academic schools must be handled directly with the school of your choice and is NOT included in IMG Academies sport tuition.

Step 6: Optional Tuition Insurance Plan

Tuition Insurance is optional for those who pay in full and mandatory for those who choose the Payment Plan. The Tuition Insurance Plan will provide substantial assistance in meeting your financial obligation in case your child is forced to withdraw because of:

The cost of Tuition Insurance is **4.75%** of your Sport Program Tuition, Athletic Development Plans, and Upgrades. It is due on August 1st, 2010 or FOUR (4) weeks prior to arrival.

HOW TUITION INSURANCE WORKS

The tuition insurance is provided by A.W.G. Dewar Inc., a third party insurance carrier, and administered by IMG Academies. IMG Academies will be named as the primary beneficiary and proceeds will go first to cover all unpaid balances and any remaining funds will be refunded to the parent who paid the tuition. If a remaining balance exists, parents are responsible for the outstanding amount. All aspects of the optional tuition insurance are subject to the terms of the contract with A.W.G. Dewar Inc.

WITHDRAWAL OR ABSENCE FOR MEDICAL REASONS

- The Plan will pay **50%** of the unused yearly insured fees, provided the student's **injury or sickness** forces the student to withdraw from IMG Academies or medical absence lasts for 31 or more consecutive days. Benefits are paid retroactive to the first day of medical absence.
- The Plan will pay **50%** of the unused yearly insured fees, provided the student's **mental/psychological disability**, as referenced in DSM IV, forces the student to withdraw from IMG Academies or medical absence lasts for 31 or more consecutive days.

Note: This plan does not provide coverage for Epidemic Closure of the school of any kind or closure due to fear of contagion.

WITHDRAWAL FOR OTHER THAN MEDICAL REASONS

(Examples include: moves, change of objective, financial hardship and voluntary withdrawals.)

- The Plan will pay **50%** of the unused yearly insured fees provided the student has withdrawn from school **after attending more than fourteen consecutive calendar days** beginning with the student's first class day of attendance in the academic year.

DISMISSAL FROM THE SCHOOL

- The Plan will pay **50%** of the unused yearly insured fees provided the student is dismissed from IMG Academies **after attending more than fourteen consecutive calendar days** beginning with the student's first class day of attendance in the academic year.
