## Step 1: Determine if you are going to be a **BASEBALL BOARDING** or a **NON-BOARDING** student

### Boarding Includes:

The BASEBALL program, group physical and mental conditioning, performance elective, COMBINE360 testing, video analysis, nutritional education, transportation to and from local evening and weekend activities, routine drug testing, standard student housing and three meals a day in our junior dining hall.

### Non-boarding Includes:

The BASEBALL program, group physical and mental conditioning, performance elective, COMBINE360 testing, video analysis, nutritional education, routine drug testing and lunch in our junior dining hall.

## Step 4: Determine if you want/need to purchase TUITION INSURANCE - mandatory if paying via the Payment Plan, OTHERWISE OPTIONAL

Tuition Insurance is optional for those who pay in full and mandatory for those who choose the Payment Plan. The Tuition Insurance provides substantial assistance in meeting your financial obligation in case your child is forced to withdraw because of:

### How Tuition Insurance works

The tuition insurance is provided by A.W.G. Dewar Inc., a third party insurance carrier, and administered by IMG Academies. IMG Academies will be named as the primary beneficiary and proceeds will go first to cover all unpaid balances. Any remaining funds will be refunded to the parent/guardian/sponsor that paid the tuition. If a remaining balance exists, parents are responsible for the outstanding amount. All aspects of the optional tuition insurance are subject to the terms of the contract with A.W.G. Dewar Inc.

## Final Step: Determine if you are paying IN FULL or via PAYMENT PLAN

**PAY IN FULL:** Payment (minus the non-refundable deposit of \$6,000) is due August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 along with the Enrollment Agreement.

**PAYMENT PLAN:** The Payment Plan is paid in NINE (9) installments throughout the year and tuition insurance is mandatory. Payment ONE (1) is due August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 and will include 30% of your SPORT + ACADEMIC TUITION less your deposit. Payments TWO – NINE (2-9) will be split into EIGHT (8) equal installments and will be due the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month, starting on September 1<sup>st</sup> and ending on April 1<sup>st</sup>.

\*Required for students 19 and under and refundable if not used.

\*\*ALL students are required to carry an IMG Academies approved US insurance card from a US insurance company. If you DO have an IMG Academies approved US insurance card from a US insurance company, this does not apply to you. In the event that you DO NOT have an accepted US insurance card it must be purchased.

### EXPLANATION OF FEES & DEPOSITS:

**Medical Deposit (boarding students only)** – Used only for emergency medical purposes when health insurance or the credit card provided on the Consent for Treatment form does not cover medical expenses or for whatever portion that is not covered by insurance, co-pay or when payment is required at time of visit.

**Property/Room Damage Deposit (Boarding students only)** – Used to cover any and all property damages that might be caused by the student (either alone or with other students) to any Academies' property.

**Personal Spending Deposit** – These are suggested amounts and will be available to cover student's incidental expenses including, but not limited to, the following areas: sport shops purchases, Bistro purchases, pocket money, laundry services, replacement for room keys, miscellaneous bills. Funds will be placed into a personal spending account to be used specifically by the student. If personal spending account reaches or falls below \$100, the student will be notified and is responsible for arranging for the deposit of additional spending money.

**Tournament Deposit** – Used for the purpose of the payment of tournament expenses.

**Competition and Training Gear Fee** – Each sport at IMG Academies has different requirements when it comes to their competition and training gear fee. Depending on the sport, the competition covers travel expenses, while other sports use a tournament account. In most cases all sports have a training gear fee that covers an Under Armour distribution of gear for training, travel and competition purposes.

### OTHER POTENTIAL COSTS:

When enrolling into IMG Pendleton, if it is determined that your child needs extra assistance based on learning differences or low scores on the TOEFL exam, we have the following Academic Enrichment Programs available:

**Learning Resource Center Program** – The IMG Pendleton School offers a program that has three levels for students managing language based learning differences, such as: ADD, ADHD, Dyslexia, Dyscalculia, Dysgraphia (program can cost between \$500 - \$3,700 year depending on the situation).

**English Language Learners** – Students enrolling at the IMG Pendleton School with less than an acceptable TOEFL score are tested and will be placed in supplemental English language classes until their English competency tests at an acceptable level. Students usually take two classes per semester until they test out and/or reach an acceptable level (program cost \$650/semester).

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
